FRECKENHAM FARMERS MARKET IS BACK ON SATURDAY 25TH SEPTEMBER 10 – 12 NOON INDOOR & OUTDOOR – In the Garden – WITH REFRESHMENTS!

Many of our regular stallholders will be there and we welcome a few newcomers too. Sunnica Awareness stand will also be there. We will still be inside and outside stalls with fingers crossed about the weather! Marilyn Badger (knitted goods) is doing a tombola for Macmillan so if you have any treasures you would like to donate please let Marilyn know in advance so she can be organised for the tombola tickets. Brenda Knowles has been our chief refreshment organiser for events like the Farmers Market for many years, which has been a fantastic help to the trustees. She now feels she no longer wanted to be responsible for this and recruiting the necessary volunteers. I know that cuppa and cake has been sadly missed as the social side of the market and for those who actually would like to sit for a bit!! So Diana of the Coffee Caravan is going to take it on from 25th September and commit to 3 months, She did say it would be helpful if there was a volunteer to help with clearing tables. This works well as not sure what we will do for a December market this year! Then we can see where we are if “volunteers” come forward to do it for their chosen charity (even the VH as a charity).

Refreshment seating will be inside but hope perhaps have some café tables outside too. We will still be operating a one-way system round so you don't miss any stalls, so entrance is from the main doors of the hall with exit on the allotment side. Hand sanitiser stations at the entrance and again at the exit, social distancing will be expected from you and please try not to touch things on the stalls, ask the stallholders and do try and bring your own bags.
